

CHAPTER LVI.

An Act to establish the County of Kanabec.

SECTION 1. Boundaries of the County—Location of the County-Seat.

2. Board of Commissioners to be appointed by the Governor—All other officers to be appointed by Commissioners.
3. Act to be submitted to the Electors for approval.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Boundaries

SECTION 1. That so much of the County of Pine and State of Minnesota, as lies within the following boundaries, be, and the same is hereby established as the County of Kanabec. Beginning at the south-east corner of township thirty-eight (38), range twenty-three (23), west; thence west to the south-west corner of township thirty-eight (38), range twenty-five (25), west; thence north to the north-east corner of township forty (40), range twenty-five (25), west; thence east to the south-west corner of township forty-one (41), range twenty-four (24), west; thence north to the north-west corner of township forty-two (42), range twenty-four (24), west; thence east to the north-east corner of township forty-two (42), range twenty-two (22), west; thence south to the south-east corner of [township] forty-one (41), range twenty-two (22), west, to the north-east corner of township forty (40), range twenty-three (23), west; thence south to the place of beginning. The County-Seat of said county is hereby located at Brunswick.

County seat

County commissioners

SEC. 2. The Governor shall appoint three suitable persons, who shall constitute a Board of County Commissioners for said county, who shall hold their offices until the next general election, or until their successors are duly elected and qualified; and the said Board of Commissioners shall have power to appoint all other officers in and for said county; and said Commissioners shall have full power and authority to do and perform all acts and duties devolving upon the Board of County Commissioners of any other county in this State.

Submission to a vote of the electors of their county

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect on and after its adoption by a majority of the Electors of Pine county, at the next general election.

CHAPTER LVII.

An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to establish the County of Monongalia."

- SECTION 1. Boundary of the County.
 2. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That townships one hundred and twenty (120), one hundred and twenty-one (121), and one hundred and twenty-two (122), of range thirty-six (36), be added unto ; Boundaries and that townships one hundred and eighteen (118), and one hundred and nineteen (119), of ranges thirty-three (33), and thirty-four (34), be taken from the county of Monongalia ; and said county shall be attached to the 20th representative district for election purposes.

SEC. 2. This Act shall be in force from and after its provisions are adopted by the electors of the counties affected thereby.
