CHAPTER LVII.

An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to establish the County of Monongalia."

SECTION 1. Boundary of the County.

2. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That townships one hundred and twenty (120), one hundred and twenty-one (121), and one hundred and Boundaries twenty-two (122), of range thirty-six (36), be added unto; and that townships one hundred and eighteen (118), and one hundred and nineteen (119), of ranges thirty-three (33), and thirty-four (34), be taken from the county of Monongalia; and said county shall be attached to the 20th representative district for election purposes.

SEC. 2. This Act shall be in force from and after its provisions are adopted by the electors of the counties affected

thereby.
