

CHAPTER IX.

An Act to Incorporate the Town of Senterville.

- SECTION 1. Corporate limits of the town.
 2. First election for town officers.
 3. Corporate powers of the town.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Boundary SECTION 1. That so much land in the county of Stearns, and State of Minnesota, as has been surveyed, plated, and located, in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county, under the name of Marysville, and Senter's Addition thereto, be and the same is hereby created a town corporate by the name of Senterville.

First election SEC. 2. That for the good government of said town, it shall be lawful for the qualified voters to meet at the usual place of holding elections of said town (Senterville), on the first Wednesday of April next, and at the same time annually thereafter, to elect one President, one Recorder, and three Trustees, being householders of said town, and having the qualifications of electors, shall hold their offices for one year, or till their successors are duly elected and qualified, and such President, Recorder, and Trustees, shall constitute the Town Council of said town, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Corporate powers SEC. 3. The President, Recorder, and Trustees of said town, shall be and are hereby created a body corporate and politic, with perpetual succession, to be known and distinguished by the name of the town of Senterville, and their duties and privileges shall be the same as those described and allowed in an Act to Incorporate the town of St. Cloud, Approved March 1st, 1856.

Take effect SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.
