An. Act to amend an act entitled "An Act to regulate corporations for Manufacturing, Mining, Agricultural, Mechanical and Chemical purposes," passed August twelfth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.

SECTION 1. Add Sec. 28. Adoption of Sections 11, 13, 18, and 14 into the charter of corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That said act is hereby amended by adding

thereto the following Section:

SEC. 23. Any corporation created before the passage of this Act, may, by a vote of a majority of its stockholders, adopt Corporation may Sections eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13) and fourteen sdopt into its (14), or either of them, as a part of its charter, and thereupon, charter Sections the Section or Sections of this Act, so adopted, shall be a part 11, 12, 13, and of the charter of said corporation; Provided, That such adoption and amendment shall not operate to extend the liability of

any stockholder of such corporation, beyond the limit established in its original charter.
