That the Secretary of State be and is hereby directed to procure the immediate publication, in pamphlet form, of the General Laws, passed this session for township and Joint resolution county organizations, and to regulate elections in this State. directing publiand the act prescribing the duties of County Treasurers, and catton of General the act prescribing the duties of County Auditors, and also Laws in pana brief abstract of the law in relation to the levying and col-phic form lection of taxes, so far as the same relates to the sale of lands for delinquent taxes; and to transmit to the Auditors of the various counties of the State for the use of the several towns in said counties, a sufficient number of such pamphlets; the Secretary of State is also directed not to procure the publication of said laws for township and county organization, and to regulate elections in this State, and the act prescribing the duties of County Treasurers, and the act prescribing the duties of County Auditors, in the State paper; but the publication of said laws in pamphle, form shall be in lieu of the publication thereof in the State paper.
