

CHAPTER XXVIII.

An Act to provide for the location of a State Road from Minneiska to Beaver.

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed.
 2. Meeting of Commissioners.
 3. May employ help.
 4. Appraisal of damages. Jury.
 5. Power to discontinue portion of Road.
 6. Who to pay expenses.
 7. Plat of Road to be filed.
 8. When Act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Albert Pomeroy, W. J. Duley, and A. P. Foster, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State road from Minneiska, in Wabashaw county, to Beaver, in Winona County. Names of Commissioners.

SEC. 2. The Commissioners shall meet at such place as may be deemed most convenient, on any day subsequent to the passage of this Act, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed on them by the provisions of this Act, *Provided* : That in the absence of any one of said Commissioners, the other two shall have the power to fill said vacancy, by the appointment of some suitable person, who shall have the same authority, as is by this Act conferred upon the said Commissioners above named. Meeting of Commissioners.

SEC. 3. That the said Commissioners are hereby empowered to employ one surveyor, two chainmen, and one axman. May employ help.

SEC. 4. That it shall be the duty of the said Commissioners, to appraise the damages sustained by each owner of land through which the said road shall pass : *Provided*, that in case any of the said owners shall feel himself aggrieved by said appraisal, he may, within thirty days, appeal in writing to the Chairman of Supervisors of the town wherein said owner may reside; and the said Supervisor shall cause a constable of his town to summon a jury of twelve freeholders, who shall proceed to examine said road, a majority of whom shall determine the amount of damages, if any, the said owner has sustained. Appraisal of damages.

SEC. 5. That the said Commissioners shall have the power to discontinue any portion of the present State road from Minneiska to Beaver, which in their discretion, shall be for the best interests of the public, within one year after the passage of this Act. Power to discontinue Road.

SEC. 6. That each county through which said road shall pass, shall pay the expenses incurred in the location of the same, in proportion to the length of said road in each county. Expenses. how paid.

SEC. 7. That the said Commissioners shall cause to be

A copy of plat to be filed. deposited and filed in the office of Register of Deeds of the counties through which the said road may pass, a copy of the plat of said road, together with their appraisal of damages, an exemplification of which shall be legal evidence of the opening and existence of said road.

Sec. 8. This Act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXIX.

An Act to amend an act entitled an Act to amend an act entitled an Act to Incorporate the City of Stillwater, approved March first, eighteen hundred and fifty-six.

- SECTION 1. Amends section five of chapter two.
2. Amends section ten of chapter three.
3. Amends section two of chapter four.
4. Amends section one of chapter five, and adds a new section.
5. Amends section one of chapter seven.
6. When this Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section five (5) of chapter two (2), be and the same is hereby amended, to read as follows :

“Sec. 5. All persons entitled to vote for County and State of officers, and who shall have resided in the City for six (6) months next preceding the election, shall be entitled to vote for any officers to be elected under this law, and to hold any office hereby created ; *Provided*, such person shall have paid the amount of the last poll tax assessed against him prior to such election.”

SEC. 2. That section ten of chapter three, be, and the same is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following words :
