

CHAPTER XXXI.

An Act for the Relief of the Mississippi and Rum River Boom Company.

- SECTION 1. Time for completion of Boom extended.
 2. Amends section eight of Act of Incorporation.
 3. Amends sections thirteen and fourteen of said Act.
 4. Amends section twenty of said Act.
 5. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Extension of SECTION 1. That the time for the completion of the Missis-
time. sippi and Rum River boom be, and the same is extended until
 the first day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and
 sixty-three.

Amendment SEC. 2. That section eight of an Act entitled "an Act to
of section eight. incorporate the Mississippi and Rum River Boom Company,"
 approved May twenty-first, one thousand eight hundred and
 fifty-seven, be amended by striking out the word "two"
 where it occurs therein, and inserting the word "one" instead
 thereof.

Of sections thir- SEC. 3. That sections thirteen and fourteen of said Act,
teen and four- be amended by striking out the words "thirty-six" where
teen. they occur in said sections and inserting the word "twelve"
 in place thereof.

Of section twenty. SEC. 4. That section twenty of said act be amended by
 striking out the words "the duty of the corporation to turn
 all such logs loose," where they occur in said section, and
 inserting instead thereof the words "at the option of said
Rafting Logs. Company to raft said logs or not, but the said corporation
 shall receive no pay for rafting said logs after they have
 been notified by the owners that they do not desire the same
 rafted."

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and
 after its passage.
