## CHAPTER XXXI.

An Act for the Relief of the Mississippi and Rum River Boom Company.

SECTION 1. Time for completion of Room extended.

2 Amends exciton eight of Actof Incorporation.

3. Amends as-times thirteen and fourteen of said Act.

4. Amends exciton twenty of said Act.

5. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the time for the completion of the Missis-Extension of sippi and Rum River boom be, and the same is extended until the first day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three.

Sec. 2. That section eight of an Act entitled "an Act to Amendment incorporate the Mississippi and Rum River Boom Company," of section eight. approved May twenty-first, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, be amended by striking out the word "two" where it occurs therein, and inserting the word "one" instead thereof.

Sec. 3. That sections thirteen and fourteen of said Act, of sections thir be amended by striking out the words "thirty-six" where toon. they occur in said sections and inserting the word "twelve" in place thereof.

That section twenty of said act be amended by Sec. 4. Of section twenty, striking out the words "the duty of the corporation to turn all such logs loose," where they occur in said section, and inserting instead thereof the words "at the option of said Rafting Loga. Company to raft said logs or not, but the said corporation shall receive no pay for rafting said logs after they have been notified by the owners that they do not desire the same

rafted." Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
