Section 1. It shall be the duty of the first board of county commissioners which shall be elected in pursuance of this act, as soon after said board shall have been elected and qualified according to law, as the said board or a majority thereof shall determine to locate the county seat of said county to all intents and purposes until otherwise provided by law.

Sec. 4. The county of Renville is hereby attached to the county of Nicollet, for judicial purposes, until the county officers of said county shall have been elected and qualified as contemplated by this act.

SEC. 5. That from and after the election and qualification sixth Judicial of the county officers of Renville county as aforesaid the said county shall be included in the sixth judicial district.

Sec. 6. The change in the county lines of Renville county submitted to vote as provided for in section one of this act shall be submitted to the electors of the counties affected by said change at the next general election for their approval or rejection.

SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect from and after its adop-

tion.
