

CHAPTER XLVI.

An Act to legalize certain acts of the President of the Town of Freeborn.

SECTION 1. Legalizes notice of entry of Town of Freeborn.
When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That the notice of the entry of the town of Freeborn, at the United States Land Office at Chatfield, for the relief and benefit of the rightful claimants thereof, which has been given by the President of said town, be, and is hereby declared to be legal and sufficient. Legalizes notice of entry.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An Act to establish the County of Ripley.

SECTION 1. Boundaries of Ripley County.
2. To be ratified. Governor to appoint County officers.
3. County Seat.
4. County to be included in Fourth Judicial District.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much of said State as is contained within the following boundaries to wit: Beginning at the Boundaries
