

CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act changing the name of Hamilton McAlpin to William Hamilton McAlpin Archibald, and constituting him heir at law of John S. Archibald and Catherine E. Archibald.

SECTION 1. Changes name of Hamilton McAlpin to William Hamilton McAlpin Archibald.
2. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of Hamilton McAlpin be and the same is hereby changed to William Hamilton McAlpin Archibald, and the said William Hamilton McAlpin Archibald be and hereby is constituted the legal heir and representative of John S. Archibald and Catherine E. Archibald, his wife.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXIX.

An Act Annexing a portion of the Town of Sumner to the Town of Spring Valley.

SECTION 1. Enlarges the Town of Spring Valley.
2. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the portion of the Town of Sumner, in the County of Fillmore, known as sections four (4), the east

one-half (1-2) of section five (5), and sections seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), and eighteen (18), in the township one hundred and three (103) north of range thirteen (13) west, be and the same is hereby annexed to, and made a part of the Town of Spring Valley, in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXX.

An Act for the relief of the Proprietors, Occupants and Claimants of the Town of Portland, in St. Louis County.

- SECTION 1. Time extended for claimants of the Town of Portland to April first, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty.
2. Repealing section.
3. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the time now required by law for each and every person, or association or company of persons claiming to be an occupant or occupants, or to have or possess or to be entitled to the right of occupancy or possession of lands which have been entered at the proper Land Offices by the corporate authority of a town or the Judge or Judges of the District Court, which lands have been settled and occupied as a site of such town pursuant to and by virtue of the provisions of the Act of Congress entitled "An Act for
