

CHAPTER LXXVII.

An Act to amend an act, entitled "An Act relative to Free Schools in the City of St. Paul," approved March first, eighteen hundred and fifty-six; and to amend "An Act amending the Foregoing Act," Approved February twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and fifty-seven.

- SECTION 1. Repeals section eleven of former Act.
 2. Repeals section ten of former Act.
 3. Amends section eleven of a former amendatory Act, authorizes and limits special tax.
 4. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section eleven (11), of an act entitled "an act relative to free schools in the city of St. Paul," approved March first, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That section ten, (10), of an act amending an act entitled "an act relative to free schools in the city of St. Paul" approved February twenty-sixth, A. D. eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That section eleven (11), of an act amending an act, entitled "an act relative to free schools in the city of St. Paul," approved February twenty-sixth, A. D. eighteen hundred and fifth-seven, be amended so as to read as follows, viz:

SECTION ELEVEN (11). The board of education shall, also, whenever in their judgment, additional means may be necessary for the support of free schools in the city of St. Paul, or for the erection of school houses therein, on or before the first day of June of each year, present to the Common Council of the city, a statement of the amount of money, beyond that in their treasury, needed for such purposes; and said Common Council are hereby authorized, if in their opinion it is expedient, to levy a tax for such purposes, on all real and personal property within this city, according to the city assessment roll, which shall be collected in the same manner as the moneys to defray the general expenses of said city, and, when collected, shall be subject to the order of the said board of education; provided, that the levy of such tax shall, in no one year, exceed one mill on the dollar of the property on said assessment roll.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

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CHAPTER LXXVIII.

An Act to authorize the town of Saint Cloud to levy a tax.

SECTION 1. Supervisors of the Town of St. Cloud authorized to levy a certain tax for the building of a Bridge.
2. Warrant to be issued to Town Collector. His duties and compensation.
3. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SEC. 1. That the Supervisors of the town of St. Cloud are hereby authorized to levy the tax voted by the electors of said township for the building of a bridge therein, on the taxable property of said township, as found on the tax roll for said township, for the year eighteen hundred and fifty-nine. Tax for Bridge.

SEC. 2. That said Supervisors, after assessing the tax voted as aforesaid, on the taxable property in said township, as found on the assessment roll of eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, shall issue a warrant under their hands, directed to the Town Collector, directing him forthwith to collect said tax ; and said Collector shall pay the tax so collected to the chairman of the Board of Town Supervisors, in thirty days from the date of said warrant ; and he shall be subject to the same penalties, and have the same powers and compensation Warrant to Town Collector.
