

Manner of releasing real estate heretofore attached

shall have been recorded at length, then that such release or discharge shall in like manner be recorded at length in the book of mortgages, and shall make an entry of the same in the same manner as is required for the entry of satisfaction and discharge of mortgages upon real estate, and the said register shall receive for such entry and recording, the same fees as are by law allowed him for the entry and recording of satisfaction of mortgages upon real estate, and no other fee or reward whatever.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XVIII.

*An Act to Amend An Act for a Homestead Exemption,
Passed August 12, 1858.*

SECTION 1. One sewing machine exempt from execution.
2. Act when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

What to be exempt from execution

SECTION 1. That section eight of said act, being section ninety-nine of chapter sixty-one of the public statutes, be amended by adding the following clause to the enumeration of household articles exempted from execution: "*Ninth*—One sewing machine."

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
