CHAPTER XXXII.

An Act to Provide for Filling Vacancies in the Office of Clerk of the District Court.

SECTIONS 1. District judge to appoint suitable person to fill vacancy—to give bond.
2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That whenever any vacancy shall occur in the office of clerk of the district court, in any county in this State, it shall be the duty of the judge of the district court for the district in which such county is situate, to appoint some suitable person to fill such vacancy, who shall give such bond and take such oath or affirmation as is by law required of clerks of the district court, and who shall hold his office until the next general election, and until his successor is elected and qualified. SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
