We therefore respectfully ask that you will establish such service at least twice each week ; commencing at St. Paul and serving the following offices, viz : West St. Paul, Eagantown, Rosemont, Lakeville and Christiana, in Dakota County ; Hazelwood, Union Lake, Millersburgh and Shieldsville in Rice County ; Kilkenney, Cordova, Oleveland and Kasota, in LeSueur County, and Mankato in Blue Earth County.
