

CHAPTER XXVIII.

An Act Changing the Boundary Lines of Sherburne County.

SECTION 1. Boundary established and defined.
 2. Act; when to take effect,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. The boundary lines of Sherburne county shall be as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Mississippi river and the range line between range twenty-five (25) and twenty-six (26); thence north on said line to the township line between townships thirty-five (35) and thirty-six (36); thence west on said line to the Mississippi river; thence along the middle of the main channel of the Mississippi river to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect on the proclamation of the Governor, of the adoption of the same by a majority of the electors of the counties of Ramsey and Sherburne respectively, present and voting thereon at the next general election.
