CHAPTER XXIX.

An Act to Define the Boundaries of Otter Tail County.

SECTION 1. Boundaries defined. 2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Boundaries defined

Section 1. That so much territory as is embraced in the following described limits be, and the same is hereby created into the county of Otter Tail: Commencing at the corner of townships one hundred and thirty and one hundred and thirty-one north, of ranges thirty-five and thirty-six west of fifth principal meridian; thence north on said range line between ranges thirty-five and thirtysix to the corner of townships one hundred and thirtyseven and one hundred and thirty-eight north, of ranges thirty-five and thirty-six west; thence west along said township line between townships one hundred and thirty-seven and one hundred and thirty-eight north, to the range line between ranges forty-three and forty-four; thence south on the range line between forty-three and forty-four to the corner of townships one hundred and thirty and one hundred and thirty-one north, of ranges forty-three and forty-four west; thence east along the township line between townships one hundred and thirty and one hundred and thirty-one to the place of beginning

Act, when to take effect SEC. 2. This act shall take effect on the proclamation of the Governor of the adoption of the same by a majority of the electors of said county present and voting thereon at the next general election.
