CHAPTER XL.

An Act Relating to the Town of La Crescent.

SECTION 1. Repeal of former acts-manner of levying taxes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That so much of section two of chapter thirty-eight of special laws, approved February 2d, 1858, as requires the appointment of a special assessor of taxes, Repeal of former is hereby repealed, and hereafter the town council of the town of La Crescent in levying a tax for corporation purposes, shall take as the basis of assessment, the assessments made for State and county purposes. Approved March 8th, A. D. 1861.

CHAPTER XLI.

An Act to Vacate the Town of Woodstock, in the County of Stearns.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the whole of the town plat of Woodstock, as recorded in the office of the register of deeds for Stearns county, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Approved March 8th, A. D. 1861.
