

CHAPTER LXIV.

An Act for the Relief of Joint School District number One of the Towns of Excelsior and Chanhassan, in Hennepin and Carver Counties.

- SECTION 1. Tax voted for by said district, declared valid.
 2. Authorized to levy and collect tax to pay present indebtedness.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That the tax voted by said school district December 2d, 1859, (said district being then known as school district number 47, in Hennepin county) is hereby declared legal and valid, and the clerk of the district is empowered to collect the same or so much as remains delinquent and unpaid in the manner prescribed by law. Tax declared valid

SEC. 2. That said district is hereby authorized and empowered to assess and collect a tax or taxes, at such times as it may determine, to pay its present indebtedness. Authorized to levy tax—for what purpose

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXV.

An Act for the relief of School District number one, in the Town of Bloomington, Hennepin County, and Legalizing the Tax assessed therein for building a School House.

- SECTION 1. Taxes assessed and warrants issued for the year 1859, declared valid,
