

CHAPTER LXX.

An Act to legalize the organization of the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anthony, and to change the name thereof.

- SECTION 1. Organization of said church legalized.
 2. Change of name.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the organization of the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anthony, be and the same is hereby legalized. Organization legalized

SEC. 2. That the name of the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anthony, be and the same is hereby changed to that of the Andrew Church. Change of name

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXI.

An Act to allow the Trustees of the Minnesota Seminary to occupy the North half of the Public Square in Wasioja, for Educational Purposes.

- SECTION 1. Authorized to occupy part of public square—for what purpose.
 2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the trustees of the Minnesota Semi-

nary, and their successors, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to occupy the north half of the public square of the town of Wasioja in the county of Dodge, for public educational purposes only.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXII.

An Act to authorize the Clerk of the District Court of the Sixth Judicial District and County of Sibley to Transcribe the Records of his office.

- SECTION 1. Clerk to procure new judgment book or books, and docket. To transcribe—what. Such judgments, records, and docket to be as valid as the original records.
2. County Commissioners to provide for purchase of necessary books—compensation of clerk.
3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Duty of clerk—what to be as valid as original records

SECTION 1. The Clerk of the District Court of the sixth judicial district and county of Sibley is hereby authorized and required to procure, if necessary, a new judgment book or books and judgment docket book, and such other books as may be required to carry out the provisions of this Act, at the expense of the county of Sibley, and to transcribe all judgments and all entries in any judgment docket, and all the records of the said court, into such new books to be provided, and the said judgment or judgments so transcribed, and the docket of the same and the records transcribed in such new books shall be and remain as valid and of the same force and effect as the original records, and no judgment lien shall be affected or impaired thereby.
