

CHAPTER XXXVII.

An Act Amending Section One hundred and sixty-one of Chapter Sixty of the Compiled Statutes, Relating to Attachments.

SECTION 1. Amendment to section 161. When defendant may apply to the court to vacate warrant of attachment.

2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and sixty-one (161) of chapter sixty (60) of the compiled statutes, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 161. If the defendant shall not have given an undertaking as provided in the last two preceding sections, he may at any time before the time for answering expires, or at any time thereafter, when he shall have answered and before trial, apply to the court on notice to vacate the warrant of attachment.

When defendant may apply to the court to vacate warrant of attachment

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
