

## CHAPTER XLII.

*An Act to Amend Section One of Chapter Forty-three of the General Laws of Eighteen hundred and Sixty, occurring on page Two hundred and three.*

SECTION 1. Amendment to section 1. Vacancy in the office of court commissioner—how filled.  
 2. Act, when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter 43 of the general laws of 1860, be amended by adding thereto the following:

Vacancy in the  
 office of court  
 commissioner—  
 how filled

That whenever any vacancy shall occur in the office of court commissioner in any county in this State, it shall be the duty of the judge of the district court for the district in which such county is situated, to appoint some competent person to fill such vacancy, who shall give such bond and take such oath or affirmation as is by law required of court commissioners and who shall hold his office until the next general election, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. ~~March 4th, 1862.~~
