

CHAPTER LX.

An Act to Amend an Act Entitled "An Act to Regulate Insurance Companies not Incorporated by the State of Minnesota," Approved February Sixth, Eighteen hundred and sixty.

- SECTION 1. Privileges extended to all life insurance companies.
2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Privileges extended to all life insurance companies

SECTION 1. That the provisions of the act entitled "an act to regulate insurance companies not incorporated by the State of Minnesota," approved February sixth, (6th) eighteen hundred and sixty, (1860) be and the same are hereby extended to all "life insurance companies," formed or incorporated under the law of any State of the United States, other than the State of Minnesota, or incorporated under any foreign state or government.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
