tion against the person or persons causing such obstructions, in the name of the supervisors of such town, in any court having competent jurisdiction, the sum thus acquired to be paid to the town treasurer for the use of the town.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXI.

## An Act Authorizing the Recording of Certificates of United States Land Officers.

SECTION 1. That the receiver's receipt or certificate of purchase of public lands, signed by the receiver, and the What may be recertificate of any register or receiver, of the entry or pur- corded in the of-chase of any tract or tracts of land by a military land needs Register of Receiver. warrant, shall be allowed to be recorded in the office of Deeds the register of deeds in the county in which the land described in such receipt or certificate is situated, and that the record of all certificates of any register or receiver of the entry or purchase of land heretofore made, is hereby declared legal and valid.

This act shall take effect and be in force from SEC. 2. and after its passage.
