SEC. 4. That such publication in German must be done at a cost not exceeding that of the publication in English, and that no extra charges be made for translating. Cost for printing

SEC. 5. That before making any disbursements out of the treasury of the State for such publication, duly certified copies of all the laws so published shall have been furnished to the proper State officer. Duty of publisher

SEC. 6. The laws published by the provisions of this act in the Norwegian language shall be in pamphlet form and shall be distributed by the secretary of state. Laws in Norwe-

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXIII.

*An Act to Amend "An Act for a Homestead Exemption,"  
Approved August Twelfth, Eighteen hundred and fifty-  
eight.*

SECTION 1. Provisions of this act to apply to the platted town of Minneapolis.  
2. Act, when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the provisions of said act shall apply to the platted town of Minneapolis and the several additions thereto, the same as though said town was incorporated. To apply to the

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
