A Memorial to Congress for the Establishment of a Mail Route by Steamers, from Detroit, Michigan, to the Head of Lake Superior, in Minnesota.

To the Honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States in Congress assembled :

The Legislature of the State of Minnesota would respectfully represent :

That the present mail facilities afforded to the people of Lake Superior are entirely inadequate to meet the wants of that section of the country.

To congress for
the establishment
of a mail route
from Detroit to
the head of Lake
Superior

That the growing commercial interest of Lake Superior demand an increase of mail service; and the establishment of a mail route by steamers, weekly, from Detroit, Michigan, to Duluth, in the State of Minnesota.

Therefore, your memorialists, the legislature of the State of Minnesota, most respectfully ask of congress the establishment of the above specified mail route, and that service be ordered thereon.
