CHAPTER XXXI.

· An Act to Define the Boundaries of Becker County.

SECTION 1. Boundary lines of Becker county.
2. Repeal of acts inconsistent with this act.
3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the boundaries of Becker county be and the same are hereby established as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the north west corner of township one hundred and forty-two, range forty-three; thence eastwardly along the line between townships one hundred and forty-two and one hundred and forty-three, to the Boundary line of north east corner of township one hundred and forty-two, Becker county range thirty-six; thence southwardly along the line between ranges thirty-five and thirty-six to the south east corner of township one hundred and thirty-eight, range thirty-six; thence westwardly along the line between townships one hundred and thirty-seven and one hundred and thirty-eight, to the south west corner of township one hundred and thirty-eight, range forty-three; thence northwardly along the line between ranges forty-three and forty-four, to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with

this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
