CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An Act to Authorize the Collection of a Portion of the County Tax in Anoka County in Gold and Silver.

SECTION 1. Authorized to collect portion of said taxes in specie—for what purpose.
2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the commissioners of Anoka county are hereby authorized to order the collection of a portion of the county tax of said county, not to exceed two mills on the dollar of valuation, in gold and silver, for the purpose of paying the interest on the county debt.
