

CHAPTER VI.

An Act to repeal "an act to Incorporate the Town of Minneapolis, in the County of Hennepin," and to provide for collecting the delinquent tax of said corporation, levied for the year 1858.

SECTION 1. Repeal of former acts.

2. Delinquent tax of 1858, declared valid and legal—duty of clerk of said corporation.

3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That "an act to incorporate the town of Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin," approved March first, A. D. 1856, together with all acts and parts of acts amendatory thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal of former acts

SEC. 2. That the delinquent corporation tax of said town for the year A. D. 1858, is hereby declared valid and legal, and the clerk of said corporation shall forthwith return to the treasurer of the county of Hennepin, a list of said delinquent taxes, and said county treasurer shall proceed to collect the same, with the other taxes, in the manner prescribed by law for the collection of taxes, and when collected, shall pay the same over to the treasurer of the township of Minneapolis, to be applied by him under the direction of the board of supervisors of said town, in liquidating the indebtedness of said corporation. Delinquent tax declared valid—duty of clerk

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
