Blakely, clerk of the house of representatives, do hereby certify, that the above act "to provide for a modification of a portion of the city of Rochester, in the county of Olmsted," after having passed the senate and house of representatives, was presented to the Governor for his signature, on Tuesday, the twenty-fifth day of February, eighteen hundred and sixty-two. We do further certify, that the said act was not returned by the Governor within three days after it was presented to him, and that its becoming a law has not been prevented by the adjournment of the legislature.

## CHAPTER LXIX.

*An Act to Legalize the act of the Common Council of the City of Wabashaw, in Levying a Tax for City Purposes, and for Support of the Poor.*

- SECTION 1. Levying a tax for the support of the poor declared legal and valid.  
 2. By whom said tax collected.  
 3. Act, when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the act of the common council of the city of Wabashaw in levying a tax of five mills on the dollar, for city purposes, and two mills on the dollar for the support of the poor, done on the fourth day of September, A. D., 1861, be and the same is hereby declared legal and valid and to be in full force and effect.

SEC. 2. The county treasurer of Wabashaw county, is hereby authorized to proceed and collect the said taxes according to the law now in force for the collection of county and State taxes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXX.

### *An Act to Change the Number of Assessors in the City of Rochester.*

- SECTION 1. But one assessor elected annually.  
 2. How elected—term of office.  
 3. Duty of assessor.  
 4. Repeal of acts inconsistent with this act.  
 5. Act, when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. From and after the passage of this act, there shall be but one assessor elected annually in the city of Rochester.

But one assessor  
elected annually

SEC. 2. He shall be elected at large, on the general ticket, at the annual election of city officers for said city, and hold his office one year, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

How elected—  
term of office

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the assessor to make the valuation of the property in each ward separate from the others, and return the same to the county auditor.

Duty of assessor

SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
