

CHAPTER VII.

An Act to Define the Boundary Line of the Town of McLean, in the County of Ramsey.

- SECTION 1. Boundary line of the town of McLean.
 2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the northern boundary line of the town of McLean, in the county of Ramsey, be extended so as to include the following portions of the town of New Canada, in said county, as follows :

Commencing at the north-west corner of section four, (4) in town twenty-eight, (28) range twenty-two, (22) thence northerly, along the boundary line between New Canada town and the city of Saint Paul, to the south-west corner of section twenty-eight, (28) town twenty-nine, (29) range twenty-two, (22) thence east along the south line of sections 28, 27, 26 and 25 of said town to the Washington county line, thence south, along the Washington county line to the north-east corner of town 28, range 22.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
