An Act to Change the Name of Lauritz Johnson to that of Levois Johnson.

SECTION 1. Change of name. 2. Act, when to take effect.

SECTION 1. That the name of Lauritz Johnson, now Change of name of the county of Goodhue, in this State, be and the same is hereby changed and declared to be Lewis Johnson.

SEC. 2. Said Edson Augustus Green, is hereby declared to be the legal heir of Chancey B. Green, of the county of Houston, and State of Minnesota, and he shall enjoy all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same care and guardianship, as if he had been the son of said Chancey B. Green, born in lawful wedlock.

This act shall take effect and be in force from Sec. 3. and after its passage.
