

CHAPTER XCI.

An Act to Prevent the Destruction of a Bank Note Plate.

- SECTION 1. State Auditor to retain in his possession the bank note plate of the Central Bank.
2. Repeal of acts inconsistent with this act.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The State Auditor is hereby authorized and required to retain in his possession, without injury or destruction, the engraved bank note plate, known as the Central Bank of New Ulm.

Duty of State Auditor

Repeal of acts inconsistent with this act

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
