

and the same is hereby extended for the present year to the twentieth (20th) day of October next.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XV.

An Act to amend an act entitled "an act for a Homestead Exemption," passed August 12th, 1858.

SECTION 1. Amendment to sub-division 5 of section 8. What property exempt.
2. Act when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That sub-division five (5) of section eight (8) of an act entitled "an act for a homestead exemption" passed August twelfth (12th,) eighteen hundred and fifty-eight (1858), be amended so as to read as follows:

What property
exempt

5. All fire-arms and other weapons of defense, all wearing apparel of the debtor and his family; all stoves and appendages, put up or kept for the use of the debtor and his family; all cooking utensils, and other household furniture not herein enumerated, not exceeding five hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
