SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER X.

*An Act to enable Joseph R. Brown to obtain record evidence of title to lots in the town of Henderson, according to the recorded plat thereof.*

- SECTION 1. Commissioner appointed to take testimony in relation to title of any lot—
1. power of commissioner.
  2. Duty of said commissioner.
  3. When power of commission to expire.
  4. Act when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Appointment of commissioner—  
for what purpose

SECTION 1. That Henry Poehler, of Henderson, in the county of Sibley, is hereby appointed a commissioner to take testimony in relation to the title of Joseph R. Brown to any lots in the town of Henderson, according to the plat thereof, as recorded in the office of the Register of deeds for the county of Sibley, with power to administer oaths to witnesses.

SEC. 2. When the commissioner appointed under this act shall be satisfied upon the hearing of the testimony that Joseph R. Brown has had, made, executed and delivered to him a good, sufficient, absolute and

unconditional deed or deeds of conveyance to any lot or lots in the said town of Henderson by any former town council thereof, and that the said deed or deeds have been destroyed or lost, without having been recorded, he shall proceed to make out a duplicate or copy of any such deed or deeds, with his certificate thereon, setting forth that the same is a true copy of the original; and such copy, so certified, shall be admitted to record the same as the original might have been, and such record and copy shall be as conclusive evidence of title, as the original deed and record thereof would be.

Duty of commis-  
sioners

SEC. 3. The power of said commissioner shall expire in one year from the passage of this act.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XI.

*An Act to amend an act for the consolidation of the vil-  
lage of Chatfield for school purposes.*

SECTION 1. Amendment to sections 1, 4, and 10.
