

Interest how paid sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds and to create a sinking fund to pay the principal at the time of the maturity of such bonds, which shall be applied for no other purpose.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved September 26th, 1862.

CHAPTER II.

An Act to legalize the action of the board of commissioners of the county of Dakota in issuing bonds for the payment of bounties to volunteers, and to provide for the levy of taxes to meet the interest and principal on the same.

SECTION 1. Legalization and validity of action of board of commissioners.
 2. To levy tax for purpose of paying interest on said bonds.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Action of board of commissioners made legal and valid SECTION 1. That the action of the county commissioners of the county of Dakota in issuing bonds for the payment of bounties to volunteers, be, and the same is hereby legalized and made valid, and the payment of the interest and principal of the said bonds shall be binding upon the county of Dakota, the same as if the action of the said commissioners had been authorized by the Legislature.

Interest on bonds how paid SEC. 2. The board of commissioners of the said county of Dakota are hereby authorized and empowered to levy taxes upon the assessment roll for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, or any subsequent year or years thereafter, as the said commissioners may

direct, to meet the payment of the interest accruing on said bonds, or to redeem the principal thereof.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved, September 24th, 1862.

CHAPTER III.

An Act legalizing warrants issued by Hennepin county as bounties to volunteers, and authorizing the board of county commissioners of said county to fund the same or to levy a tax therefor.

- SECTION 1. Warrants issued by board of county commissioners for [bounty] to [volunteers] declared legal and binding.
2. To levy tax for the purpose of paying outstanding warrants.
 3. Authorized to issue bonds—at what rate of interest.
 4. Authorized to levy a tax for the purpose of paying interest and principal on said bonds.
 5. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The several county warrants or orders heretofore issued by the county commissioners of Hennepin county to volunteers enlisted in the military service of the United States, payable out of any moneys in the treasury of said county appropriated for bounty to volunteers in any or either of the Minnesota regiments, after the Legislature shall have authorized the levying of a tax therefor, are hereby declared a legal and binding indebtedness against said county, and the same shall be receivable in payment of all county taxes.

SEC. 2. The board of county commissioners of said county are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, either to fund said indebtedness, or any part thereof, in the manner provided in this act, or to assess
