

CHAPTER XXIII.

An Act to Define the Boundaries of the Fifth District for the Survey of Logs, Lumber, and Timber, and to create the Seventh District.

- SECTION 1. Boundaries of the Fifth and Seventh Districts.
 2. Location of the office of the Surveyor General of the Seventh District.
 3. Repeal of acts inconsistent with this act.
 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Boundaries of the
Fifth and Sev-
enth Districts

SECTION 1. The Mississippi river and its tributaries, below the outlet of Lake Pepin to the southern line of Wabashaw county, shall constitute the Fifth District. The Mississippi river and its tributaries from the southern line of Wabashaw county to the southern line of the State of Minnesota, shall constitute the Seventh District.

SEC. 2. The Surveyor General of the Seventh District shall keep his office at the city of Winona.

Repeal of inconsis-
tent acts

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
