*Joint Resolution Relative to the Fees of Surveyors of School Lands.**Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota,*

Relative to the
fees of Surveyors
of School Lands

That the Commissioner of Public Lands is hereby instructed to allow the bills of the surveyors employed to survey School Lands, under the late appraisement of such lands at the rate of three dollars per day for the time certified by the board of appraisers, and that in all future surveys of School Lands, the compensation of the surveyor shall be three dollars per day.]

*Joint Resolution, Accepting the Donation of Lands by Congress for the Endowment of an Agricultural and Mechanical College.**Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota,*

That the donation of public lands by Congress to the several States and Territories, by an act approved July 5th, 1862, entitled "an act donating public lands to the several States and Territories," which may provide colleges for the benefit of agriculture and mechanic arts, together with all the stipulations of said act, are assented to and accepted by this State.
