Joint Resolution Relative to the Apportionment of School Moneys in the Border Counties for 1863.

WHEREAS, It is by law made the duty of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to apportion among the several counties of the State, on the first Monday in February, the available current school funds in the State Treasury; and

WHEREAS, It appears that on account of the late Indian raid, the Auditors of many of the border counties have been unable to make returns to the State Superintendent for the current year; therefore

Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Relative to the apportionment of the school money in the border counties

That the State Superintendent is hereby authorized, at his discretion, to take as a basis for apportionment in the counties thus affected, for the present year, the returns made to the office of Public Instruction, for the year 1861.
