Joint Resolution in Relation to a Deposit of Ten Thousand Dollars, by the Saint Paul and Pacific Railroad Company.

Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That the deposit required by the act of the Legislature of this State, entitled "an act to facilitate the construction of the Minnesota and Pacific Railroad, and to amend and continue the act of incorporation in relation thereto," approved March 10th, 1862, of ten thousand dollars, as evidence of the good faith and ability of said Company to construct the portion of said road between St. Anthony and Anoka, within the time named therein, is hereby dispensed with.
