CHAPTER XI.

An Act for the Relief of those Persons who Lost Property by Fire, in the City of Winona, July 5th, 1862.

SECTION 1. Authorized to abate the tax levied on real and personal property for the year 1862.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Authorized to
abate the tax levied

personal property

SECTION 1. That the Commissioners of the county of Winona, are hereby authorized to abate the tax levied on real and personal property for the year 1862, that may be shown to the satisfaction of said Commissioners to have been consumed by fire, in the city of Winona, on the morning of the fifth day of July, 1862; *Provided*, That no abatement shall be made for more than the assessed valuation of said property, deducting from such abatement so much as may have been actually paid as insurance on the property so destroyed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
