

## CHAPTER XIX.

*An Act to Authorize the County Commissioners of Fillmore County to Issue County Orders, bearing Interest, in Payment of Bounty to Volunteers, and to empower the said Commissioners to levy Taxes for the Redemption thereof.*

- SECTION 1. County Commissioners authorized to issue orders for aid to families of volunteers.  
 2. May levy a tax—for what purpose.  
 3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the Commissioners of Fillmore county be, and they are hereby authorized to issue the county orders of said county, in payment of bounty to volunteers, who have, when residents of said county, volunteered in the military service of the United States, under the two calls of the President of the United States, for six hundred thousand men, said orders to bear interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum, from the time of issue until redeemed, and to be redeemable, one-third in two years, one-third in three years, and one-third in four years, by special tax, to be levied upon the taxable property of said county, in three separate taxes, to meet the three issues of said orders as they shall become due, which orders shall be signed by the County Auditor, and countersigned by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners.

Authorized to issue orders to aid families of volunteers

SEC. 2. The County Commissioners of said county are hereby empowered to levy such tax or taxes, upon the taxable property of said county, as found upon the assessment rolls of 1864, or any subsequent year, as shall be sufficient to redeem the county orders which may be hereafter issued agreeably with the provisions of this act.

May levy a tax—for what purpose

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
