## CHAPTER XXXII.

### *An Act for the relief of School District No. Eighteen (18) in Faribault County.*

SECTION 1. Action of the legal voters of school district No. 18 legalized.  
 2. Authorized to draw share of Public School Fund.  
 3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the action of the legal voters of School District No. Eighteen (18) in Faribault county, had at their annual meeting in May, 1862, and at all subsequent meetings in the election of officers, and the transaction of such other business as was necessary to their organization as a school district, be and the same is hereby declared legal and binding upon the inhabitants and property owners of said district, any thing in section 26, of "an act to provide for a general system of common schools, the officers thereof, and their respective duties and powers," approved March 6, 1862, to the contrary notwithstanding.

Action of the legal voters legalized

Sec. 2. Said school district shall upon proper returns being made as required by the existing school law, be

entitled to draw its proportionate share of the public school fund, and shall be held to be for all purposes connected with their organization, a legally constituted school district.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

Approved, February 20, 1863.

### CHAPTER XXXIII.

*An Act for the Relief of Inver Grove School District, in the County of Dakota, and legalize the Tax assessed therein by the Trustees of said District for the support of Common Schools.*

SECTION 1. Taxes assessed in said school district legalized.  
2. Duty of County Treasurer.  
3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

Legalization of  
taxes assessed

SECTION 1. That the tax assessed by the trustees of Inver Grove school district in the county of Dakota, in the month of December, 1861, of four hundred dollars for the support of schools in said Inver Grove school district; also, the sub-district taxes levied at the same time for sub-district purposes, are hereby declared legal and valid.

Duty of County  
Treasurer

SEC. 2. The County Treasurer of the county of Dakota, is hereby authorized to proceed and collect the said taxes according to the law now in force for the collection of county and State taxes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
