CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An Act for the Relief of School Districts in the Counties of Le Sueur, Fillmore and Ramsey.

SECTION 1. Legal voters of said counties may vote to appropriate money for the purpose of building school houses.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the legal voters of any school district in the counties of Le Sueur, Fillmore and Ramsey, may at any tax meeting of the voters of such district, levy any amount of money for the purpose of building a school house, or purchasing a site for the same, or both, in said district, not to exceed six hundred dollars, except the first school district in Le Sueur, in Le Sueur county, which may increase the amount for said district by a vote of the majority of the legal voters, at a regular meeting called for that purpose, to any amount not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars, such taxes to be levied and collected as other taxes for school purposes are levied and collected.

Legal voters may vote to appropriate money for the purposes of building school houses

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
