

Sec. 8. The rates charged for crossing the above ferry, shall not exceed the following:

For each foot passenger, - - - - -	5 cents.

For each two horse or mule team, loaded or unloaded, - - - - -	25 “	
For each single horse and carriage, - - - - -	15 “

All freights, merchandize, or other articles, not in teams, at the rate of five cents per hundred pounds, and fifty cents per thousand feet of lumber.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act Authorizing Katharine F. Fullerton to Sell and Convey certain Real Estate, therein mentioned, as a Femme Sole.

- SECTION 1. Right to sell and convey certain real estate herein mentioned.
 2. Duty of County Treasurer.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Katharine F. Fullerton, of Somerville, in the County of Middlesex, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and a married woman, the wife of James Fullerton, be and she is hereby authorized and empowered, to sell and convey by deed, an undivided half part of lots six (6), seven (7), eight (8), and nine (9), in block numbered eighty (80), in the town of Min-

neapolis, as the same is platted and recorded in Hennepin county, in this State (and of which she is seized in her own right), in the same manner and with like effect as she might or could do if sole and unmarried; and that the deed of conveyance of said premises, and its appurtenances, duly executed by the said Katharine, shall be valid and effectual, and convey the same right, title, and interest therein, as would be conveyed by the joint deed thereto executed, by the said Katharine F. Fullerton and James Fullerton, her husband.

SEC. 2. The Register of Deeds in and for the county of Hennepin, in this State, is hereby authorized to place upon the land records in his office, a certified copy of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXIX.

An Act for the Relief of the Estate of Lyman Ruby, deceased.

SECTION 1. Time extended for the execution of the official trust of the administrators of the estate of Lyman Ruby.

SECTION 1. The time for the execution of the official trust of the administrators of the estate of Lyman Ruby, late of the county of Scott, and State of Minnesota, deceased, is hereby extended for the period of one year and three months from the date of the approval of this act. Said administrators are hereby authorized and empowered in all things pertaining to the administration
