CHAPTER XXV.

An Act fixing the time of holding the general terms of the District Court in Dakota County.

SECTION 1. Time for holding general term of District Court in Dakota County.

- 2. All write, recognizances, etc., desined to be returned to such court.
- Repeal of former act.
 When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Time for holding general term of court SECTION 1. That the general terms of the district court in and for the county of Dakota, in the first judicial district, shall be held on the third Tuesday in June, and the second Tuesday in January, of each year.

All writs, recognisances, etc., to be returned to such court

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and other proceedings made returnable to the district court in and for said Dakota county, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of such court as they are fixed by this act, and all continuances and notices now made or taken to the district court of said county, shall be deemed to be made or taken to the next term thereof, as fixed by this act.

Repeal of former

SEC. 3. That so much of the act approved February twenty-ninth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, as related to the time of holding said court, in said Dakota county, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
