Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

. SECTION 1. That section fifty-two, of chapter sixtyone, page five hundred and sixty-three of the compiled statutes of Minnesota, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to wit:

Section 52. A reference may be ordered to any person or persons, not exceeding three, agreed upon by the parties, or if the parties do not agree, the court or judge must appoint one or more persons, not exceeding three, who may be residents of any county of this State, having the qualification of electors.

That all acts or parts of acts in conflict SEC. 2. with said section, as hereby amended, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
