CHAPTER XLVI.

An Act to provide for Recording Deeds, Mortgages, or other conveyances of lands in the counties of Redwood and Cottonwood.

SECTION L. Duty of Register of Deeds of Brown county.

- 2. The record of any deed, mortgage, stc., shall be as valid as if the same had been recorded in the county where the land is situated.
- 3. Fees of the Register of Deeds of Brown county.
- 4. When set to take effort.

Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The register of deeds of Brown county in this State, is hereby authorized and directed to receive and record, in the records of said county, all Duty of register of deeds, mortgages or other conveyances, of any lands county lying and being in the counties of Redwood and Cottonwood, in this State. Said register of deeds shall enter in the reception book, in his office, the date of the reception of such deed, mortgage or other conveyance, and shall enter the names of the grantor and grantee in the proper index, with the description of land and place of record, in the same manuer as is now provided by law for the record of deeds, mortgages or other conveyances of lands.

waSEC. 2. The record of any deed, mortgage, or other conveyance of lands, lying in the counties of veltety of said Redwood and Cottonwood, in the office of the register more of deeds of Brown county, as hereinbefore provided, shall be as valid, and shall have the same effect in law and in equity, to all intents and purposes, as if the same had been recorded in the office of register of deeds of the county in which such lands shall lie.

SEC. 3. The register of deeds of Brown county rest of regime shall receive the same fees for recording any instrument under this act as is now allowed by law for recording similar instruments.

SEC. 4. This act is hereby declared to be a public act, and shall take effect and be in force from and after 13

its passage, and shall continue in force until February 1, 1865.

CHAPTER XLVII.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An act to regulate elections in this State, and to reduce the several acts relating to the same to one act," approved March twelfth, eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

SECTION 1. Amondment to Section 23. Abstract of canvase of votes for county officers, and change of county lines to be made on one sheet. 2. When act to take effect.

Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty-two of an act entitled "an act to regulate elections in this State and to reduce the several acts relating to the same to one act," approved March 12th, 1861, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 22. The abstract of the canvass of votes for probate judges, sheriffs, coroners, county auditors, county treasurers, registers of deeds, county surveyors, clerks of the district court, county attorneys, court commissioners, county commissioners and all such other officers as now are, or hereafter may be established in any of the counties or districts of this State, and of the votes upon any proposed change of county lines or county seat, shall be made on one sheet, and being certified and signed in the same manner as in case of abstracts of votes for the officers named in the first section of this act, shall be deposited in the said auditor's office, and a copy
