CHAPTER LVI.

An Act imposing a fine for running the Toll Gate of any Bridge Company or individual.

SECTION I. Penalty for running tall gate or refusing to pay tall-fine how collected.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Penalty for running toll gate or refusing to pay toll-fine how col-

SECTION 1. Whenever any bridge or ferry company or individual is authorized by law to collect toll for the crossing of any bridge or ferry belonging to such company or individual, any person who shall willfully run the toll gate of such company or individual, and pass over such bridge or ferry with the intention of avoiding the payment of the toll prescribed by law, or who shall refuse to pay such toll when thereto lawfully requested, shall forfeit and pay for the use and benefit of the county wherein such bridge or ferry shall be located, a fine of five dollars for each and every such offence, which fine shall be proscented and collected, together with costs, in the same manner as penalties prescribed for riding or driving upon any such bridge, faster than a walk, are authorized to be collected.

This act shall take effect immediately.
