

be transmitted to the county auditor by the town clerk of said town, within ten days thereafter.

SEC. 3. If, upon the receipt of the returns from the above-mentioned town, the county auditor shall find that there is a majority in favor of said tax, then the auditor shall levy a tax of ten mills on the dollar, upon all the taxable property in said town, and for said services he shall receive a reasonable compensation.

Duty of county auditor if in favor of said assessment

SEC. 4. The tax so levied shall be collected by the treasurer of said county in the manner, as provided by law for the collection of any taxes assessed in said county.

Taxes so levied how collected

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXIV.

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Steele County to issue bonds.

SECTION 1. County Commissioners authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Steele are hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of the county, to an amount not exceeding the sum of six thousand dollars, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding twelve per cent. per annum, for the purpose of raising money to meet an appropriation heretofore made by said county for bounties to soldiers enlisting from said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved January 30, 1864.

CHAPTER. XXV.

An Act to authorize the town of New Canada, in Ramsey county, to borrow money for the purpose of paying a bounty to soldiers.

SECTION 1. Supervisors of said town authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose—when made payable—at what rate of interest.

2. Duty of County Auditor.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION. 1. That for the purpose of enabling the town of New Canada to borrow money to pay the bounty offered by said town to each volunteer enlisting therefrom in the military service of the United States, under the call of the President, the supervisors of said town are hereby authorized to issue bonds, orders, or certificates of indebtedness to an amount sufficient for the purpose, payable in one, two, three and four years, with interest, at a rate not exceeding eight per cent. per annum, and to levy such a tax from time to time as may be necessary to pay such interest and principal, as the same shall become due.

SEC. 2. The county auditor of Ramsey county is hereby authorized to recall the tax duplicate of 1863 from the county treasurer, and extend thereon the tax levied, or which may be levied, by said town for the payment of said bounty, or any portion thereof, and return the same to the treasurer for collection.
